#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Mud n Tars MCC, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the Mud n Tars 2018 Dirt Track Closed to Club Series for Classic Solo & Sidecar, Modern Solo & Sidecar, Junior Solo at the aforementioned venues, on the aforementioned dates.

### 2. **JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The above mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C18088 & C18089 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences for all classes except Demo Class; and Single Recreational Activity Licences or Non-Competition Licences for Demo Class.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

#### 3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and riders are encouraged to **enter online**, discount rates apply. Online Entries close at midnight the Friday immediately prior to race date, postal entries close last mail on the Friday immediately prior to race day, and on the day entries at 8:45 am race day (please tender the correct fee at sign on). Round 3 NO on the day entry, State Title event.
- In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

### 4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3 IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.

#### 9 AWARDS:

Ribbons awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd of each Series Round. All Demo entries will receive a prize of equal value. Riders must compete in at least 2 rounds of Series to receive end of year trophy.

### 10 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 5 or at the discretion of the
- 10.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the club, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

#### 11 **RACE FORMAT**:

Modern Solos - 3 laps of practice, 4x 5 laps of heats.

Juniors, Sidecars, & Classic Solos – 3 laps of practice, 4 x 4 laps of heats. Time allowing (points allocated on completed rounds) Demo 50cc, 3 lap sessions.

Solo format when there are less than 12 entries per class: Points accumulated by each competitor over 4 rounds of racing will determine results.

**Solo format when there are more than 12 entries per class**: After 3 rounds of qualifying heats (4 laps heats) the top 12 points scorers go into the final (5 laps). Points from the final only determine results.

**Sidecar format when there are more than 6 entries per class**. After 3 rounds of qualifying heats the top 5 points scorers go into the final. Points from the final only determine results.

#### 12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Dirt Track Competition.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 12.3 Change of machine may be permitted up to 10 minutes prior to the start of the event in which substitution machine is required. Provided that notice is given to, and approval given by the MSA Stewards. The substitute must have been passed at machine examination.
- 12.4 Sidecars: One bike per class as per the intent of the rules. A junior capacity machine is not eligible in a senior class and a pre 1974 machine is not eligible for post 1974 races.

# 14 ALL RIDERS SHOULD SUPPLY AN ABLE BODIED PERSON OVER 16 YEARS TO DO A FLAG SHIFT, CANTEEN OR OFFICIAL DUTY. NO FLAG MARSHALLS, NO RACING.

#### 15 GRID POSITIONS:

Peg selection will determine your gate pick for the first race. Thereafter your gate selection will be determined by your previous race finishing position.

### 16 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

Riders Practice: Riders are required to attend at Practice.

#### 17 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 17.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 17.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.
- 17.3 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be from the start of scrutineering with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue. Also, this event will be deemed to be finished at the completion of the riding time or 30 mins after the last rider completes the course.

### 18 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

Left and right hand bends of graded dolomite racing in an anti-clockwise direction.

#### 21 STARTS:

30 and 5 second boards and either drop-back gates or rubber band starts

#### 22 RACING:

See 8 for classes and 11 for format.

#### Important Information for Junior Riders:

- 22.1 A rider's age on 1 January will determine his/her age for competition that year. However, a rider may move to the next higher class when he/she becomes eligible to do so during the year, but once a rider moves to the higher age class in any competition, he/she may not go back to the lower age class. Points earned in a lower age class will not transfer to the higher class. This rule will apply to all riders up to and including 16 years old.
- 22.2 If you start in an age group at the beginning of the series and if you move up into the next age group during the year, you cannot drop back and finish the series.
- 22.3 Logbooks All junior riders **MUST** hand their Log Book in at Sign On.
- 22.4 Junior and Senior Back numbers are Compulsory.

#### 24 GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$75.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

#### 25 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 25.1 Presentation to be held as soon as practical after racing finishes.
- 25.2 Bar, Catering and Toilet facilities at venue.
- 25.3 No Riding of motorbikes or pushbikes in the pits or carpark \$50.00 fine will be imposed
- 25.4 No open toed shoes allowed in the pits.
- 25.5 No dogs allowed anywhere at venue except Guide Dogs.
- 25.6 NO ALCOHOL and NO SMOKING permitted in pits.
- 25.7 Dumping of fuel or oils on the ground are prohibited. Please use the waste liquid drums provided.
- 25.8 Public Admission is free.
- 25.9 Rear Tyres- Road, Trials Universal, Speedway or Dirt Track tyres are allowed. No Motocross Knobby or claw pattern allowed
- 25.10 Junior Size machines with up to and including 85cc 2 str/150cc 4 stroke big wheel machines are except from tyre restrictions.
- 25.11 Back Protectors must comply with GCR 18.9.4.5 For Road Race, Dirt Track and Track events, in the case of competitor's wearing apparel as described in 18.9.4.1 and 18.9.4.2 and 18.9.4.3:
  - a) Commercially manufactured armour which protects the shoulders and the back or a leather or similar jacket with in-built back protection or a jacket and commercially manufactured back protector,
  - b) Protection of the back must be continuous and cover all of the back area between the collar and the base of the spine,
  - c) Where the armour is not constructed as a one-piece suit type, knee and elbow guards must be used in Dirt Track.

### 25.12 Junior and Senior Back numbers are Compulsory.

- 25.13 Environmental Protection GCR 20.14.5.3 Environmental protection: An absorbent mat that measures 500x500mm minimum must be placed underneath the engine/gearbox and fuel tank of any solo or sidecar while parked in the pit, paddock or work area.
- 25.14 FUEL TESTING MAY BE CARRIED OUT AT ANY TIME DURING THIS EVENT as per GCR 19.14.2

  "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

#### ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:

  that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
  that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
  that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
- that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided; that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured; that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are

- I irrevocably authorise MA and my SCB and hereby appoint MA and my SCB as my lawful attorneys to collect from my Carers, and I hereby direct my Carers to provide to MA or my SCB upon request being made by MA or my SCB, any of my Information including but not limited to any information concerning any incident or event causing or contributing to or resulting from any injury, illness or death to me, the details of any diagnosis and prognosis provided to me by my Carers (or any party with the knowledge of any of my Carers), and any other matter to the knowledge of my Carers that might reasonably be considered to be requested by MA or my SCB for the purpose of improving safety at MA and SCB events.
